- Collaborate with our supply chain to achieve best practice sustainability outcomes in our workforce by supporting local jobs and upskilling of the local labour forces

The Project Director, Commercial Manager and Sustainability Manager will be responsible for upholding this policy and embedding sustainability into the procurement process. All staff, sub-contractors and suppliers will be required to abide by this policy and the associated procurements processes. Compliance records will be documented including any non-conformances with this Policy.
